## Personal Data Protection

1. The co-administrators of the processed personal data are the I and II degree State School of Music named after prof. Józef Świder in Jastrzębie-Zdrój located in Tadeusza Kościuszki Street 13 a, 44-300 Jastrzębie-Zdrój, (contact: (+48) 32 476 37 05, e-mail: [szkola@psmjastrzebie.pl](mailto:szkola@psmjastrzebie.pl)) and The Centre of Artistic Education (CEA) situated in Mikołaja Kopernika Street 36/40, 00-924 Warsaw, contact: (+48) 22 421 06 21, e-mail: [sekretariat@cea.art.pl](mailto:sekretariat@cea.art.pl)). The rules of responsibility of the co-administrators regarding the fulfillment of their obligations regarding the protection of personal data obtained in connection with this competition, including their mutual arrangements in the scope of this responsibility, are governed by the co-administrators' agreement.
2. Each of the co-administrators will process the personal data of competition participants provided by them voluntarily in the entry card, in order to organize and conduct the XIII International Competition "Wind Instruments" in Jastrzębie-Zdrój, in accordance with the Competition Regulations. Personal data of the competition participants may also be processed in order to promote the activities of the co-organizer, as well as to promote people presenting their skills during the competition. Therefore, your data may be included in the school's informational and promotional materials, including the website [www.psmjastrzebie.pl](http://www.psmjastrzebie.pl), the school's profile in the social media (Facebook).
3. The basis for the processing of personal data is a voluntarily expressed consent (Article 6 (1) (a) of the GDPR), which can be withdrawn at any time without affecting the processing that took place before its withdrawal. Withdrawal of the consent will result in the inability to participate in the competition or its settlement.
4. The basis for processing may also be the legitimate interest of the administrator (Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR) in connection with the investigation / defense of possible claims, handling complaints, storage for archival (evidence) purposes in order to secure information in the event of a legal need to prove facts.
5. Personal data will be processed for the period necessary to achieve the above-mentioned purposes or until the consent is withdrawn.
6. Personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making processes by the administrator, including profiling.
7. The data will not be shared with external entities, except in cases provided for by law.
8. You have the right to access your personal data and subject to the provisions of law: the right to rectify, delete or limit processing, the right to transfer data, the right to object towards processing.
9. In addition, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Office, if you believe that the processing of personal data by the administrator violates the law.
